From Lexington: Take Interstate 64 West towards Frankfort to exit #58.

Turn right at the end of the exit onto US 60 West. Stay on this road for 5 miles.

US 60 will merge with US 421 North – stay on US 421 (Wilkinson Blvd.)

until you reach the distillery on your right – look for the Buffalo Trace water tower and enter through the big stone gates.

From Louisville: Take Interstate 64 East towards Frankfort to Exit #53B/US 127 North. Go north on US 127 for 5 miles. You will cross the Kentucky River. Turn left onto US 421 South, (also Wilkinson Blvd.). The distillery will be on the left in one mile—look for the Buffalo Trace water tower and enter through the big stone gates.





TOURS

Buffalo Trace Distillery offers three different tours, each providing a unique look at the bourbon-making process and its own historical perspective. All of the tours are complimentary.



THE TRACE TOUR

The Trace Tour is offered six days a week year-round and is available to all walk-in visitors. The Trace Tour leaves from the Gift Shop on the hour with the first tour at 9 a.m. and the last tour beginning at 3 p.m. Monday - Friday. On Saturday, the first tour is at 10 a.m. with the last tour beginning at 2 p.m. During the tour you will experience a century-old aging warehouse, the hand-bottling of premium bourbons, a free sample of Buffalo Trace Kentucky Straight Bourbon Whiskey and lots of southern hospitality!

HARD HAT TOUR

The "Hard Hat" Tour is offered six days a week during our Distilling season – September through June – by reservation only. This is a behind-the-scenes view of each step in the distillation process. See it all first hand – from the grain delivery and mashing in our giant steam-generated pressure cookers to the fermentation and distillation. You will get a chance to see the pure distilled liquid, known as "white dog" coming out of our three-story column still. If you've ever wanted to know exactly what goes into crafting Buffalo Trace Bourbon, this tour is for you. Space is limited so make reservations early.

The distillery is closed for tours on Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day and New Year's Day.

POST PROHIBITION TOUR

The Post Prohibition Tour is an architectural and history-based tour. Travel back in time to the period directly following the Repeal of Prohibition, 1930s - 1950s. You'll see historical archives and photographs in our George T. Stagg Gallery, walk through the old boiler room and witness the building expansions that were added on the original distillery foundations. This tour is by reservation only.

GIFT SHOP & GEORGE T. STAGG GALLERY

Buffalo Trace offers an extensive Gift Shop for visitors. The Gift Shop is open during normal visitor hours and features great brand wear along with selected bourbons hand-signed by the Master Distiller. Special gift baskets are also available.



Just behind the Gift Shop is the George T. Stagg Gallery. The gallery features historic distillery photos and artifacts, some dating back to the days of Prohibition. The gallery is a great place to spend time while waiting for the next tour or to relax and enjoy the historic surroundings.

The Distillery is also home to great bourbons like Blanton's—the world's first single barrel bourbon—the famous Van Winkle line of bourbons and the limited edition Antique Collection.
